First Presbyterian Church, Haddonfield, retained KSK Architects Planners Historians, Inc. (KSK) to work with them to refine the scope of work and costs for contemplated facility improvements. KSK and members of the building committee developed a close partnership which helped to build congregational support for moving forward with building repairs, a major step for a congregation with limited resources but lots of faith.



KSK completed an exterior condition assessment, interior space planning of lounge and classroom spaces, and designs for entrance canopies as part of their work with the congregation to clarify the scope of work for a “wish list” of facility improvements, and eventually a list of prioritize projects with cost estimates. KSK provided renderings and a PowerPoint presentation used by church leaders to inform the congregation of project plans and goals; conducted one-on-one interviews with key church staff; and successfully took the window replacement, canopy preliminary designs, and roof replacement projects through approvals by the Haddonfield Historical Commission and Planning Commission.

Construction documents were completed for replacement of aluminum Education Building windows, but ultimately replacement of the massive slate roof was determined to be the highest priority. KSK produced construction documents and provided construction observation for this project.
