



# Morris County Historic Resources Survey, Phases I and II

Morris County retained KSK to update an existing countywide historic resources survey, and to survey additional properties that may be historically or architecturally significant. The survey provides critical information about the county's historic properties for use in County and municipal planning, and serves as a tool for the Morris County Preservation Trust, a County grant agency. In total, Phases I and II cover fourteen municipalities: Boonton, Boonton Township, Butler, Denville, Kinnelon, Lincoln Park, Mine Hill, Mountain Lakes, Pequannock, Riverdale, Rockaway Borough, Rockaway Township, Victory Gardens, and Wharton. In addition to conducting field survey and completing survey forms, KSK consulted with local representatives from each municipality to garner input about the survey goals and potential historic properties in each community. The final report provided the project methodology, historical information, analysis of survey data, and recommendations for future work. The firm also developed a cultural resources survey database for the County during Phase I, which contained survey

information, provided a method for easily updating survey information and printing survey forms, and furnished a quick reference tool for retrieving key property data. This deliverable provided a baseline for the County's design of an expanded, GIS and web-enabled database during Phase II.
